

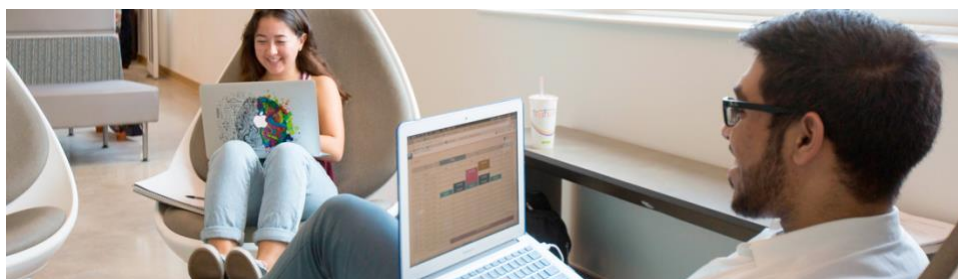
Facilitating STEM* for All Learners
