EDUCATORS EMPOWERING YOUTH CLIMATE ACTION

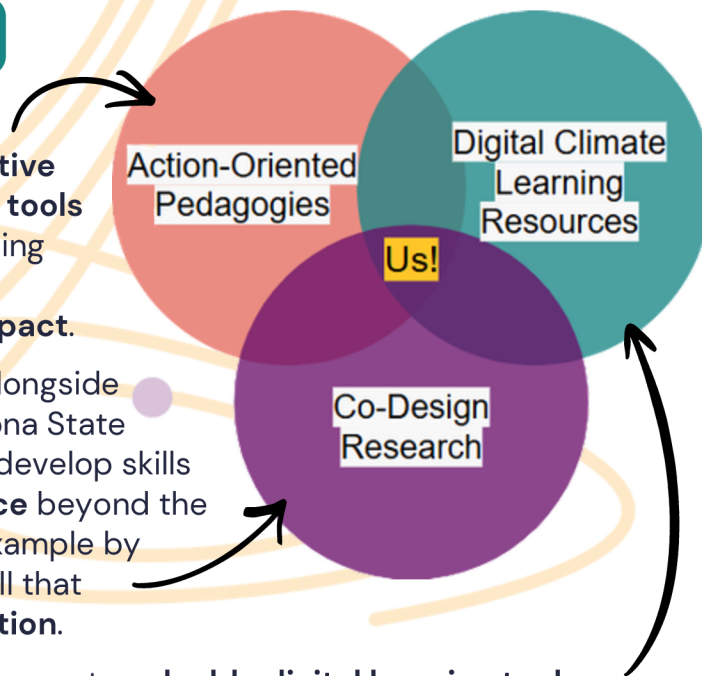
The Educators Empowering Youth Climate Action (E-EYCA) program supports **secondary school educators** in addressing **climate challenges** by centering youth agency and action, leveraging quality digital platforms for student learning, and facilitating the use of action-oriented pedagogies in the classroom. E-EYCA teachers come together over the course of a year to co-design, implement, and investigate their students' climate learning and action to drive the **creation of just and sustainable futures**.

WHY PARTICIPATE?

Participating educators will collaboratively explore **innovative pedagogical frameworks and tools** to design and implement learning cycles that bridge **content standards** with **real-world impact**.

Through co-design research alongside program facilitators from Arizona State University, educators will also develop skills that will **enhance their practice** beyond the course of the program – for example by engaging in data analysis, a skill that supports **data-driven instruction**.

Finally, educators will gain exposure to **valuable digital learning tools**, enhancing their own **climate literacy** while also identifying quality resources to be used during the program year and beyond!
